



Pax Christi International's Privacy and Data Protection Policy

What information does Pax Christi International gather and track?

In principle, access to the information available on or via the website of Pax Christi International does not require any personal data to be supplied by the user. 'Personal data' means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person; an identifiable person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identification number or to one or more factors specific to his or her identity.

However, in order to use certain online services, for example to subscribe to Pax Christi International's e-newsletter and general mailing list, or to send an information request via the 'Contact Us' form on the website, you may be asked to supply some information about yourself, such as contact details (name and e-mail address) when filling in a form.

Occasionally we may ask you to provide further personal information such as date of birth, ID/passport number, nationality, contact address in connection to a particular Pax Christi International event (conference, workshop, seminar) you may wish to attend.

Surveys

We may occasionally ask you to fill out optional surveys and/or questionnaires. These surveys/questionnaires ask for demographic information, which is not personally identifiable to you, and other information about computer use.


Internet Address Information

We use IP addresses, browser types and access times to analyse trends, administer the site, improve site performance and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use.

Cookies

The Pax Christi International website may use cookies to enhance its functionality, to help improve its performance and to provide you with a better user experience. If you wish to control what cookies are set on your device through the Pax Christi International website or delete cookies that have already been set, follow below instructions:


To delete cookies

1. → [Click to open Internet Explorer.](#)
2. Click the **Tools** button , point to **Safety**, and then click **Delete browsing history**.
3. Select the **Cookies** check box, and then click **Delete**.

- Deleting all cookies might prevent some webpages from displaying correctly.

▼ **To block or allow all cookies**

1. → [Click to open Internet Explorer.](#)
2. Click the **Tools** button , and then click **Internet options**.
3. Click the **Privacy** tab, and then, under **Settings**, move the slider to the top to block all cookies or to the bottom to allow all cookies, and then click **OK**.

Blocking cookies might prevent some webpages from displaying correctly.

Note

- Blocking all cookies can help protect your privacy, but it might limit your experience on some websites. You can start by blocking all cookies, then allow cookies as needed for websites that you trust.

Protection of Personal Data

The policy on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by Pax Christi International is based on the [Directive 95/46/EC](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 October 1995 (OJ L 281, 23.11.1995).

Pax Christi International will collect personal information only to the extent necessary to fulfill a precise purpose that will be clearly specified to the user.

Pax Christi International will not disclose any of your personally identifiable information without your permission. Nor will it reuse information you provide for a purpose incompatible with the original purpose.

Pax Christi International will not divulge your personal data for direct marketing purposes, nor will it disclose this information to third parties, except where required by law (for example to government bodies and law enforcement agencies).

Data collected will be kept for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which it is collected.
