General task

The EU fundraiser will work to obtain EU funding for Pax Christi International both for the short term as the long term.

Specific Tasks

- Identify EU funding opportunities for the work of Pax Christi International both for the short term as the long term;
- Research criteria, deadlines and application procedures;
- Write concrete funding proposals , narrative and financial, both for structural funding and programme work in close cooperation with the staff;
- Builds and strengthens solid relationships with appropriate EU instances as well as with partners and members ;
- Support PCI staff in EU project management, evaluation and monitoring;
- Ensure adequate and timely reporting ;
- Contribute to the development of the overall fundraising strategies of PCI.

Required Qualifications

- Demonstrate substantive experience in designing funding applications for the EU for non-profits;
- Have excellent knowledge about the current priorities and working procedures of the EU, in particular its funding instruments;
- Demonstrate concrete results of successful funding applications with the EU;
- Demonstrable experience of managing multiple funding applications concurrently;
- Have knowledge about evaluation and monitoring systems;
- Full professional proficiency in English – working knowledge of French, Spanish and /or Italian is highly desirable;
- Experience with strategic planning processes is highly desirable.

Required skills

- Proven interest in justice and peace issues and faith based networks;
- Self-motivated with a positive attitude and able to work efficiently and accurately to deadlines;
- Highly creative and proactive; able to generate and implement innovative ideas and strategies;
- Excellent collaborative skills and ability to establish effective working relationships with the staff of Pax Christi International;
- Outstanding written and verbal communication skills, able to interact with key partners and with EU instances;

- Strong communicator with outstanding written and verbal communication skills.

- The contract is for one year, with possibility for renewal over several years;
