

KARDINAAL ALFRINK PEACE FUND 2015

Report of activities

The Kardinaal Alfrink Peace Fund has supported Pax Christi International (PCI) in 2015 in its search for new ways to look for structural money and support.

The Pax Christi Peace Prize was awarded in 2015 to the 'Colectivo de Pensamiento y Acción Mujeres' (The Women, Peace and Security Collective for Reflection and Action) from Colombia to make more visible and promote the essential contribution of women in building of peace and promoting the ethical engagement of the Columbian society as a step towards sustainable peace. The prize was awarded in the birth church in Bethlehem by the president of the Kardinaal Alfrink Peace Fund, Etienne de Jonghe, to Rosa Emilia Salamanca, the founder of this women's initiative during the world congress of Pax Christi International at the occasion of its 70-year of existence.

The board of the Kardinaal Alfrink Peace Fund suggested the international board of PCI to give the prize in 2016 to a peace initiative in South-Asia.

The board asked Werner Caekelbergh to take over his father's position as secretary-treasurer of the board and continues its search for new women participants in the board in 2016.
